The birth of Canada was inspired by meetings of the leaders of Nova Scotia, New Brunswick and Prince Edward Island to discuss how they all might do better as a group than they could on their own. These meetings attracted the attention of Upper and Lower Canada as well, which would become Ontario and Quebec, who saw the value of this approach in growing economically and defending against a potential threat from the United States. In 1867, these colonies agreed to become the country of Canada at confederation, forming one strong body to face these challenges. (source?)
