What is an essay?

- research → find supporting information, examples
- argue → to get (a point) across
thesis
- non-fiction → paragraphs, sentences
↳ formatting

How do I write an essay?

- topic

- brainstorm - listing/jotting ideas

- plan - organize ideas before writing

- draft → rough out ideas in writing

How do I write an essay?

- revise/edit

↳ check for breakdowns

in meaning

↳ check for errors

exit

- publish → good copy → dress up
